A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE COLLECTION OF NATIVE AMERICAN DATA ON ALL STATE LEVELS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Commission on Indian Affairs, the sum of one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to enable all State departments and agencies to collect and maintain Native American-specific data. These funds may be used for designing and modifying data collection mechanisms and for employing personnel.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
