A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH STUDY COMMISSION TO STUDY
THE ISSUE OF RABIES VACCINATIONS ADMINISTERED BY CERTIFIED
RABIES VACCINATORS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Public Health Study Commission established pursuant to G.S. 120-195 shall study whether the same vaccination requirements under State law and rules should apply to rabies vaccinations administered to a dog or a cat by a certified rabies vaccinator as apply to vaccinations administered to a dog or a cat by a licensed veterinarian. In conducting this study, the Commission shall consider House Bill 329, first edition, 1999 General Assembly. The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations, including recommended legislation, to the 1999 General Assembly, Regular Session 2000, upon its convening.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
