1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A NO-WAKE ZONE IN THE WATERS OF LEE'S CUT IN
3	THE CITY OF WRIGHTSVILLE BEACH.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. It is unlawful to operate a vessel at greater than no-wake speed in
6	the waters of Lee's Cut in the Town of Wrightsville Beach in New Hanover County. No-
7	wake speed is idle speed or a slow speed creating no appreciable wake.
8	Section 2. The Town of Wrightsville Beach or its designee may place and
9	maintain markers in accordance with the Uniform Waterway Marking System and any
10	supplementary standards for that system adopted by the Wildlife Resources Commission.
11	All markers of the no-wake speed zone shall be buoys or floating signs placed in the
12	water and must be in sufficient number and size to give adequate warning of the no-wake
13	speed zone to vessels approaching from various directions.
14	Section 3. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
15	Section 4. This act is enforceable under G.S. 75A-17 as if it were a provision
16	of Chapter 75A of the General Statutes.
17	Section 5. This act is effective when it becomes law and is enforceable after
18	markers complying with Section 2 of this act are placed in the water to mark the no-wake
19	zone.
