8	required to be registered or obtain licensure under this section:	
9	(1)	Facilities licensed under Chapter 122C or Chapter 131E of the General
10		Statutes;
11	(2)	Persons subject to rules of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation
12		Services;
13	(3)	Facilities that care for no more than four persons, all of whom are under
14		the supervision of the United States Veterans Administration; and
15	(4)	Facilities that make no charges for housing, amenities, or personal care
16		service, either directly or indirectly.indirectly; and
17	<u>(5)</u>	Institutions that are maintained or operated by a unit of government and
18		that were established, maintained, or operated by a unit of government
19		and exempt from licensure by the Department on September 30, 1995."
20	Section 2. This act is effective on and after September 30, 1995.
