4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 115C-238.29F(d)(3) reads as rewritten:
6	"(3) A charter school shall conduct the student assessments required for
7	charter schools by the State Board of Education. administer the tests
8	adopted by the State Board of Education under G.S. 115C-174.11 that
9	are used to implement the School-Based Management and
10	Accountability Program in other public schools."
11	Section 2. G.S. 115C-238.29G(a) reads as rewritten:
12	"(a) The State Board of Education, or a chartering entity subject to the approval of
13	the State Board of Education, may terminate or not renew a charter upon any of the
14	following grounds:
15	(1) Failure to meet the requirements for student performance contained in
16	the charter; charter or to meet the requirements for student testing
17	<u>contained in G.S. 115C-238.29F(d)(3).</u>
18	(2) Failure to meet generally accepted standards of fiscal management;
19	(3) Violations of law;

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1	(4) Material violation of any of the conditions, standards, or procedures set
2	forth in the charter;
3	(5) Two-thirds of the faculty and instructional support personnel at the
4	school request that the charter be terminated or not renewed; or
5	(6) Other good cause identified."
6	Section 3. This section becomes effective July 1, 1999, and applies to school
7	years beginning with the 1999-2000 school year.
