A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE PROHIBITION ON LEG-GRIPPING TRAPS IN DUPLIN COUNTY AS TO BEAVER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 1266 of the 1973 Session Laws is amended by adding a new section to read:

"Section 1.1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1 of this act, leg-gripping traps may be set and used in Duplin County for the taking of beaver. Any leg-gripping trap set in accordance with this section shall meet the requirements for traps set forth in G.S. 113-291.6 and shall be set in water of sufficient depth to cover the trap."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
