May 30, 2000 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ERECT MEMORIAL SIGNS ALONG HIGHWAYS FOR STATE HIGHWAY PATROL MEMBERS AND OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The Department of Transportation shall erect signs along North Carolina's highways memorializing members of the State Highway Patrol and other law enforcement personnel who have died in the line of duty. The Department of Transportation shall coordinate the placement and contents of these memorial signs with the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
