A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of four million six hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$4,620,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina Council for Women for the continuation of domestic violence programs within the State. Of these funds, the North Carolina Council for Women shall allocate sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to each of the 76 existing domestic violence programs and to the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Inc. Of the funds appropriated in this section, two million six hundred eighty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,682,500) shall be recurring funds, and one million nine hundred thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,937,500) shall be nonrecurring funds.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
