A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REALLOCATE THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR ENFORCING THE  
UNIFORM INTERSTATE FAMILY SUPPORT ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 52C-3-308 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 52C-3-308. Representation of obligee.**

It shall be the duty of ~~the district attorney~~ any attorney who represents the child support enforcement agency in the appropriate county of this State to represent the obligee in proceedings authorized by this Chapter unless alternative arrangements are made by the obligee. An obligee may employ private counsel to represent the obligee in proceedings authorized by this Chapter."

Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1999, and applies to all proceedings begun or pending on or after that date.
