2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WILSON TO ADDRESS ABANDONED
3 STRUCTURES IN THE SAME MANNER AS MUNICIPALITIES IN COUNTIES
4 WITH A POPULATION OF OVER ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE
5 THOUSAND.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 733 of the 1995 Session Laws, as amended by
8 S.L. 1997-101, S.L. 1997-414, S.L. 1997-449, S.L. 1998-26, and S.L. 1998-87, reads as
9 rewritten:

10 "Sec. 2. This act applies to the Cities of Eden, Greenville, Lumberton, ~~and Roanoke~~
11 ~~Rapids, Roanoke Rapids, and Wilson,~~ to the municipalities in Lee County, and the Towns
12 of Bethel, Farmville, Newport, and Waynesville only."

13 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
