#### **BILL SUMMARY:**

The bill increases the fee paid to agents of the Wildlife Resources Commission to title and register boats. The bill raises the reporting requirement for accidents involving boats from \$100 in damages to \$500 in damages. The bill also repeals the law requiring permits for regattas, races, marine parades, tournaments or exhibitions.

#### ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY

Four hundred small businesses across the state serve as vessel registration agents for the Wildlife Resources Commission. These agents are paid 50 cents per transaction; a rate unchanged since 1979 (Chapter 761, 1979 S.L.). With the recent installation of the computerized Customer Support System, vessel registration agents are required to do the data entry of boat title and registration information in the field. The Wildlife Resources Commission requested this bill to better compensate the vessel registration agents for their increased workload. The amended fees will decrease Wildlife Resources Commission receipts by \$195,000 each year. (see chart on page 2) However, the Commission calculated that the cost of doing these transactions "in-house" would require 9.4 positions at a cost of \$340,768. The total cost of agent transactions at the new rates is only \$249,087.
