BILL SUMMARY: This bill provides that members appointed to the Advisory Committee on Cancer Coordination and Control for initial two-year terms may each be reappointed for one additional four-year term.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: The Advisory Committee on Cancer Coordination and Control, as a result of actions taken during SFYs 1994 and 1995, receives a General Fund recurring appropriation of approximately \$125,000. This bill does not alter the composition of this board; thus no fiscal impact is expected.
