11	Elections shall prepare a Spanish translation of ballot instructions for local board	<u>s of</u>
12	elections."	
13	SECTION 2. If Senate Bill 17 of the 2001 Session of the General Asser	nbly
14	is enacted, then G.S. 163-140.2, as enacted by Section 1 of this act, is recodified as	G.S.
15	163-165.5A.	
16	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective with respect to all prima	ries,
17	elections, and referenda held on or after August 1, 2001. This act expires Januar	y 1,
18	2012, unless extended by legislation enacted before that date.
