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HOUSE BILL 108 Short Title: Certain Counties Delinquent Taxes. (Local) Sponsors: Representatives Haire, Carpenter, and West. February 14, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CHEROKEE, GRAHAM, HAYWOOD, JACKSON, MADISON, AND SWAIN COUNTIES TO REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF DELINQUENT **PROPERTY TAXES BEFORE** RECORDING **DEEDS** CONVEYING PROPERTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 2 of Chapter 161 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 161-31. Tax certification. The board of commissioners of a county may, by resolution, require the register of deeds not to accept any deed for registration unless the county tax collector has certified that no delinquent ad valorem county taxes, ad valorem municipal taxes, or taxes with which the collector is charged are a lien on the property described in the deed." SECTION 2. This act applies only to Cherokee, Graham, Haywood, Jackson, Madison, and Swain Counties.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
