6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 163-82.6(c) reads as rewritten:		
7	(c) Registration Deadlines for an Election. – In order to be valid for an election,		
8	the form:		
9	(1) If submitted by mail, must be postmarked at least 25 days before the		
10	election, except that any mailed application on which the postmark is		
11	missing or unclear is validly submitted if received in the mail not later		
12	than 20 days before the election,		
13	(2) If submitted in person, must be received by the county board of		
14	elections by 5:00 p.m. a time established by that board, but no earlier		
15	than 5:00 P.M., on the twenty-fifth day before the election,		
16	(3) If submitted through a delegatee who violates the duty set forth in		
17	subsection (a) of this section, must be signed by the applicant and		
18	given to the delegatee not later than 25 days before the election,		
19	19 except as provided in subsection (d) of this section."		
20	0 <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective with respect to elections held on or		
21	21 after January 1, 2002.
