4	OR HER AREA OF CERTIFICATION AND TO FACILITATE THE TEACHER
5	CERTIFICATION PROCESS.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-288(a) reads as rewritten:
8	"(a) To Grade and Classify Pupils. Grade, Classify, and Assign Pupils to
9	<u>Teachers.</u> — The principal shall have authority to grade and classify pupilsgrade,
10	classify, and assign pupils to teachers, except a principal shall not require additional
11	testing of a student entering a public school from a school governed under Article 39 of
12	this Chapter if test scores from a nationally standardized test or nationally standardized
13	equivalent measure that are adequate to determine the appropriate placement of the
14	child are available. If the principal assigns a student to a teacher who is not teaching
15	within his or her area of teacher certification, the principal shall give written notice to
16	the pupil's parent or guardian. The notice shall include a statement that the named
17	teacher is not teaching within his or her area of teacher certification and information
18	about the teacher's qualifications to teach."
19	SECTION 2. Section 2 of S.L. 1998-226 reads as rewritten:
20	"Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires September 1,
21	2002, except that it remains effective for any teacher employed under this act before
22	September 1, 2002.law."
23	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies

24 beginning with the 2001-2002 school year.
