AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "TOURISM ABC ESTABLISHMENT".			
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-101(14a) reads as rewritten:			
"§ 18B-101. Definitions.			
As used in this Chapter, unless the context requires otherwise:			
 (14a)	"Tourism ABC establishment" means a restaurant or hotel that meets both of the following requirements:		
	a.	Is located on property, a property line of which is 1.5 miles of the end of an entrance or exit ramp of a national scenic parkway designed to attract national, and international tourists between the Milepost 460.469.	f a junction on local, State, State line and
	b.	Is located in a county in which the on-premises of sale of malt beverages or unfortified wine is au least one city.	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
