A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL TERM LIMITS FOR MEMBERS OF THE HAYWOOD
2 COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, EDENTON-CHOWAN COUNTY BOARD
3 OF EDUCATION, ALEXANDER COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, AND
4 IREDELL-STATESVILLE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding Section 4 of Chapter 126 of the 1963 Session
8 Laws and Section 3 of Chapter 30 of the 1967 Session Laws, members of local boards
9 of education may serve for more than two consecutive terms.

10 **SECTION 2.** Section 8 of Chapter 774 of the 1969 Session Laws reads as
11 rewritten:

12 "Sec. 8. Member(s) whose terms of office expire and who desire to become
13 candidates for re-election shall register and be voted upon in the same manner as herein
14 provided and at the general election to be held in the year in which said terms of office
15 ~~expire, provided no member shall serve more than two terms in succession.~~ expire."

16 **SECTION 3.** As allowed by G.S. 115C-67, Section 3(d) of the Plan of
17 Merger of the Iredell County and Statesville City Schools is amended by deleting the
18 sentence "No member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms."

19 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
