4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 131D-6(b) reads as rewritten:

As used in this section 'adult day care program' means the provision of group 6 "(b) care and supervision in a place other than their usual place of abode on a less than 7 8 24-hour basis to adults who may be physically or mentally disabled. The Department of Health and Human Services shall annually inspect and certify all adult day care 9 programs, under rules adopted by the Social Services Commission. The Social Services 10 Commission shall adopt rules to protect the health, safety, and welfare of persons in 11 adult day care programs. These rules shall include minimum standards relating to 12 management of the program, staffing requirements, building requirements, fire safety, 13 sanitation, nutrition, and program activities. Adult day care programs are not required to 14 provide transportation to participants, however, those programs that choose to provide 15 transportation shall comply with rules adopted by the Commission for the health and 16 safety of participants during transport. 17 The Department of Health and Human Services shall enforce the rules of the Social 18 Services Commission." 19
