#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY EXPENSE ALLOWANCE, PER DIEM 3 RATE, AND MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE

- 4 GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 120-3 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 120-3. Pay of members and officers of the General Assembly.

The Speaker of the House shall be paid an annual salary of thirty-eight 8 (a) 9 thousand one hundred fifty-one dollars (\$38,151) payable monthly, and an expense allowance of one thousand four hundred thirteen dollars (\$1,413) per month. The 10 President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall be paid an annual salary of thirty-eight 11 thousand one hundred fifty-one dollars (\$38,151) payable monthly, and an expense 12 allowance of one thousand four hundred thirteen dollars (1,413) per month. The Speaker 13 Pro Tempore of the House shall be paid an annual salary of twenty-one thousand seven 14 hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$21,739) payable monthly, and an expense allowance of 15 eight hundred thirty-six dollars (836.00) per month. The Deputy President Pro Tempore 16 of the Senate shall be paid an annual salary of twenty-one thousand seven hundred 17 18 thirty-nine dollars (\$21,739) payable monthly, and an expense allowance of eight hundred thirty-six dollars (\$836.00) per month. The majority and minority leaders in the 19 House and the majority and minority leaders in the Senate shall be paid an annual salary 20 of seventeen thousand forty-eight dollars (\$17,048) payable monthly, and an expense 21 allowance of six hundred sixty-six dollars (\$666.00) seven hundred seven dollars 22 (\$707.00) per month. 23

(b) Every other member of the General Assembly shall receive increases in annual salary only to the extent of and in the amounts equal to the average increases received by employees of the State, effective upon convening of the next Regular Session of the General Assembly after enactment of these increased amounts, except no such increase is granted upon the convening of the 1997 Regular Session of the General

12	"(a) In addition to compensation for their services, members of the General			
13	13 Assembly shall be paid the following allowances:			
14	(1)	A weekly travel allowance for each week or fraction thereof that the		
15		General Assembly is in regular or extra session. The amount of the		
16		weekly travel allowance shall be calculated for each member by		
17		multiplying the actual round-trip mileage from that member's home to		
18		the City of Raleigh by the rate per mile which is the business standard		
19		mileage rate set by the Internal Revenue Service in Rev. Proc. 93-51,		
20		December 27, 1993. Rev. Proc. 2000-48 (December 4, 2000).		
21	(2)	A travel allowance at the rate which is the business standard mileage		
22		rate set by the Internal Revenue Service in Rev. Proc. 93-51,		
23		December 27, 1993, <u>Rev. Proc. 2000-48</u> (December 4, 2000),		
24		whenever the member travels, whether in or out of session, as a		
25		representative of the General Assembly or of its committees or

33		this subdivision, while the General Assembly is not in session when,

6	(4) A member may be reimbursed for registration fees as permitted by the
7	Legislative Services Commission."
8	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective upon the convening of the 2003
9	General Assembly.
