The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to 5 Local School Administrative Units the sum of forty-three million dollars (\$43,000,000) 6 7 for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of forty-three million dollars (\$43,000,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year for low-wealth school systems' supplemental funding.
