The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 20-157 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
"(f) When an authorized emergency vehicle that is giving a warning signal as		
described in subsection (a) of this section is parked, the driver of every other vehicle		
shall, as soon as it is safe and when not otherwise directed by an individual lawfully		
directing traffic, do one of the following:		
<u>(1)</u>	When driving on an interstate highway or other highway	
	than two lanes traveling in the direction of the emerge	ncy vehicle,
	merge into the lane farthest from the emergency vehicle.	
<u>(2)</u>	When driving on a two lane road, slow to a speed that is 2	20 miles per
	hour less than the posted speed limit."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
