7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-157 is amended

8		SECTION 1. G.S. 20-157 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
9	" <u>(f)</u>	When an authorized emergency vehicle as described in subsection (a) of this

section is parked or standing within 12 feet of a roadway and is giving a warning signal by appropriate light, the driver of every other approaching vehicle shall, as soon as it is safe and when not otherwise directed by an individual lawfully directing traffic, do one of the following:

14	<u>(1)</u>	Move the vehicle into a lane that is not the lane nearest the parked or
15		standing authorized emergency vehicle and continue traveling in that
16		lane until safely clear of the authorized emergency vehicle. This
17		paragraph applies only if the roadway has at least two lanes for traffic
18		proceeding in the direction of the approaching vehicle and if the
19		approaching vehicle may change lanes safely and without interfering
20		with any vehicular traffic.
21	(2)	Slow the vehicle maintaining a safe speed for traffic conditions and

- 21(2)Slow the vehicle, maintaining a safe speed for traffic conditions, and22operate the vehicle at a reduced speed until completely past the23authorized emergency vehicle. This paragraph applies only if the24roadway has only one lane for traffic proceeding in the direction of the25approaching vehicle or if the approaching vehicle may not change26lanes safely and without interfering with any vehicular traffic.
- 27 <u>Violation of this subsection shall not be negligence per se.</u>"

1	SECTION 2. Article 28 of Chapter 66 of the General Statutes is amended by
2	adding a new section to read:
3	" <u>§ 66-207. Rental car companies assist in publicizing law.</u>
4	(a) A rental car company shall notify renters of the law requiring motorists to
5	stop for and not pass stopped school buses that are properly marked and designated and
6	that are receiving or discharging passengers. The Division of Motor Vehicles shall
7	design a written notification in English, French, German, Japanese, and Spanish and the
8	notification shall be no more than one side of a page. The Division of Motor Vehicles
9	shall also develop a design for use on placards under subdivisions (b)(2) and (b)(3) of
10	this section. The design may be used or adapted by the rental car company. The placards
11	shall consist of the words "It is unlawful in North Carolina to pass a school bus that is
12	stopped and receiving or discharging passengers.", or a visual symbol indicating passing
13	a stopped school bus is unlawful in North Carolina, or both. The Division of Motor
14	Vehicles shall publish the written notification and the design for placards on the Internet
15	and rental car companies shall obtain both by downloading and printing them from that
16	source.
17	(b) The notification required under subsection (a) of this section may be made
18	either:
19	(1) By handing each renter who presents an International Driver Permit
20	with a copy of the written notification prepared by the Division of
21	Motor Vehicles under subsection (a) of this section;
22	(2) If the rental car company operates airport shuttle buses to transport
23	renters to pick up vehicles, by posting on each bus at least one placard
24	containing a written notification or visual symbol, or both; or
25	(3) If the rental car company operates a counter at which renters pick up
26	documentation, by posting on that counter or at a place easily visible
27	from the counter at least one placard containing a written notification
28	or visual symbol, or both.
29	Each placard that contains a written notification shall provide that information in all the
30	languages listed in subsection (a) of this section.
31	(c) There shall be no civil or criminal liability in negligence nor shall an action
32	under G.S. 66-206 apply for any car rental company that fails to provide the information
33	or post the placard required by this section."
34	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act becomes effective December 1, 2001.
35	The remaining sections of this act become effective October 1, 2001.
