5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 90-354(b) reads as rewritten:		
7	"(b) Of the members initially appointed, the professional member appointed by		
8	the Governor, one of the professional members appointed by the General Assembly		
9	upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and one of		
10	the professional members appointed by the General Assembly upon the		
11	recommendation of the President of the Senate shall be appointed for three-year terms;		
12	one of the public members appointed by the Governor, one of the professional members		
13	appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the		
14	House of Representatives, and one of the professional members appointed by the		
15	General Assembly upon the recommendation of the President of the Senate shall be		
16	appointed for two-year terms; and one of the public members appointed by the		
17	Governor shall be appointed for a one-year term. After the initial terms specified in this		
18	subsection, members Members of the Board shall take office on the first day of July		
19	immediately following the expired term of that office and shall serve for a term of three		
20	years and until their successors are appointed and qualified."		
21	SECTION 2. G.S. 90-355 reads as rewritten:		
22	"§ 90-355. Election of officers; meetings of Board.		
23	(a) Within 30 days after making appointments to the Board, the Governor shall		
24	call the first meeting of the Board. The Board shall elect a chairman and a vice-		
25	chairman who shall hold office according to rules adopted by the Board.		
26	(b) The Board shall hold at least two regular meetings each year as provided by		
27	rules adopted by the Board. The Board may hold additional meetings upon the call of
