17 18 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 160A-296.1. Expenditure of funds for roads outside the corporate limits.

A city may appropriate funds not otherwise limited as to use by law to complete expanded roadway networks in areas outside its corporate boundaries and outside its extraterritorial planning and zoning jurisdiction."

SECTION 2. G.S. 136-66.3(a) reads as rewritten:

- "(a) Municipal Participation Authorized. A municipality may, but is not required to, participate in the right-of-way and construction cost of a State highway improvement approved by the Board of Transportation under G.S. 143B-350(f)(4) that is located in the municipality or its extraterritorial jurisdiction. G.S. 143B-350(f)(4)."
- **SECTION 3.** This act applies to the Town of Cary only.
- 19 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
