The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Section 3 of S.L. 1997-404 reads as rewritten: "Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to new initial claims filed on or after September 1, 1997. The Employment Security Commission shall report to the General Assembly by January 1, 2001, on the effect of this act on unemployment compensation claims. This act expires September 1, 2001."
