A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE DEVELOPMENT OF ADULT CARE HOMES

UNDER THE CERTIFICATE OF NEED LAW.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 131E-175 reads as rewritten:

"§ 131E-175. Findings of fact.

The General Assembly of North Carolina makes the following findings:

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(8) That because State and county expenditures are made to provide support for nearly three-quarters of the residents in adult care homes, it is in the public interest to promote efficiencies in delivering care in those facilities by controlling and directing their growth in an effort to prevent underutilization and higher costs and provide appropriate geographical distribution."

SECTION 2. G.S. 131E-176 reads as rewritten:

"§ 131E-176. Definitions.

As used in this Article, unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the following terms have the meanings specified:

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(9b) "Health service facility" means a hospital; psychiatric facility; rehabilitation facility; long term care facility; nursing care facility; adult care home; kidney disease treatment center, including freestanding hemodialysis units; intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded; home health agency office; chemical dependency treatment facility; diagnostic center; oncology treatment center; hospice, hospice inpatient facility, hospice residential care facility; and ambulatory surgical facility.

23	SECT	TION 3. There is established a moratorium on the development or
24	offering of any new adult care home beds from the date of ratification of this act until	
25	January 1, 2002.
