BILL SUMMARY: The bill would eliminate the $\$ 10$ additional fee for special registration plates for amateur radio operators.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: According to the Division of Motor Vehicles, there are approximately 2,700 amateur radio plates. Ratification of the bill would result in an annual loss of $\$ 27,000$ to the Special Registration Plate Account in the Highway Fund. The estimate above assumes that the bill is in effect at the beginning of the next fiscal year.
