5	(c) As used in this section, a volunteer is a person who provides services to a
6	local board of education without expectation of compensation and with the
7	understanding that the local board of education is under no obligation to continue
8	accepting those services or to compensate the volunteer for them.
9	(d) This section shall not be construed to require a local school administrative
10	unit to maintain records on volunteers, former volunteers, or persons applying to be
11	volunteers, except where there is evidence of volunteer misconduct."
12	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
