PART 1. REGULATORY FEE FOR UTILITIES COMMISSION

SECTION 1.1.(a) The percentage rate to be used in calculating the public utility regulatory fee under G.S. 62-302(b)(2) is twelve hundredths of a percent (0.12%) for each public utility's North Carolina jurisdictional revenues earned during each quarter that begins on or after July 1, 2004.

SECTION 1.1.(b) The electric membership corporation regulatory fee imposed under G.S. 62-302(b1) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year is two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000).

SECTION 1.1.(c) This section becomes effective July 1, 2004.

PART 2. INSURANCE REGULATORY CHARGE

SECTION 2.1.(a) The percentage rate to be used in calculating the insurance regulatory charge under G.S. 58-6-25 is five percent (5%) for the 2004 calendar year.

SECTION 2.1.(b) This section is effective when it becomes law.

PART 3. GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 3.1. This act does not affect the rights or liabilities of the State, a taxpayer, or another person arising under a statute amended or repealed by this act before the effective date of its amendment or repeal; nor does this act affect the right to

- any refund or credit of a tax that accrued under the amended or repealed statute before the effective date of its amendment or repeal.
- SECTION 3.2. Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act is effective when it becomes law.
