**FUNDS TO PERFORM DNA ANALYSIS OF EVIDENCE TO ASSIST LAW**  
**ENFORCEMENT AND PROSECUTORS IN CONVICTING CRIMINALS.**  
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
**SECTION 1.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
