5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
6		SECT	TON 1. G.S. 74D-7(e) reads as rewritten:
7	"(e) The Board may charge fees as follows:		
8		(1)	A nonrefundable initial license application fee in an amount not to
9			exceed one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).
10		(2)	A new or renewal license fee in an amount not to exceed three hundred
11			fifty dollars (\$350.00).five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
12		(3)	A late license renewal fee to be paid in addition to the renewal fee due
13			in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00), if the
14			license has not been renewed on or before the expiration date of the
15			license.
16		(4)	A registration fee in an amount not to exceed twenty dollars
17			(\$20.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00) plus any fees charged to the board for
18			background checks by the State Bureau of Investigation.
19		(5)	A fee for reregistration of an employee who changes employment to
20			another licensee, not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00).
21		(6)	A branch office certificate fee not to exceed one hundred fifty dollars
22			(\$150.00).
23		<u>(7)</u>	A fee not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each
24			reconsideration of a license or registration permit that has been filed or
25			returned to the applicant for correctable errors.
26	All fees collected pursuant to this section shall be expended, under the direction of the		
27	Board, for the purpose of defraying the expense of administering this Chapter."		
28	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
