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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF SUNSET HARBOR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** A Charter for the Town of Sunset Harbor is enacted to read:

"CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SUNSET HARBOR.

"ARTICLE I. INCORPORATION AND CORPORATE POWERS.

"Section 1.1. **Incorporation and Corporate Powers.** The inhabitants of the Town of Sunset Harbor are a body corporate and politic under the name 'Town of Sunset Harbor'. The Town of Sunset Harbor has all the powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities conferred and imposed upon cities by the general laws of North Carolina.

"ARTICLE II. CORPORATE BOUNDARIES.

"Section 2.1. **Town Boundaries.** Until modified in accordance with the law, the boundaries of the Town of Sunset Harbor shall be as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the run of Mercer's Mill Pond Creek where said run of Mercer's Mill Pond Creek is intercepted by the southern boundary of River Run Plantation, as the same is shown on plats of River Run Plantation recorded in the Brunswick County Registry, as extended to the west; thence running eastwardly with the southern boundary of River Run Plantation as the same is shown on plats of River Run Plantation recorded in the Brunswick County Registry; thence across Sunset Harbor Road (State Road #1112) to the western boundaries of the Old Swain Property; thence southwardly with the western boundary of the Old Swain Property to a point where said extended line intersects with the boundary line of Lockwood Folly Township and Smithville Township in the U. S. Intracoastal Waterway, thence westwardly with the boundary line of Lockwood's Folly Township and Smithville Township in the U.S. Intracoastal Waterway, back to the run of Mercer's Mill Pond Creek; thence continuing with the run of Mercer's Mill Pond Creek, to a point in the run of Mercer's Mill Pond Creek where said run of Mercer's Mill Pond Creek is intercepted by the southern

1 boundary of River Run Plantation, as the same is shown on plats of River Run  
2 Plantation recorded in the Brunswick County Registry, as extended to the west, the  
3 place and point of beginning.

4 "ARTICLE III. GOVERNING BODY.

5 "Section 3.1. **Structure of Governing Body.** The governing body of Sunset Harbor  
6 shall be the Board of Aldermen, which shall have five members and a Mayor.

7 "Section 3.2. **Temporary Officers.** Until the organizational meeting after the initial  
8 election in 2003 provided for by Section 4.1 of this Charter, Elaina Darter is hereby  
9 appointed Mayor and Dennis Ruocco, Craig Howell, Jackie Haddon, Roger Comer, and  
10 Miles Edge are appointed members of the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sunset  
11 Harbor, and they shall possess and exercise the powers granted to the governing body  
12 until their successors are elected or appointed and qualified pursuant to this Charter. If  
13 any person named in this section is unable to serve, the remaining temporary officers  
14 shall, by majority vote, appoint a person to serve until the initial municipal election is  
15 held in 2003.

16 "Section 3.3. **Manner of Electing Board of Aldermen; Terms of Office.** The  
17 qualified voters of the entire Town shall elect the members of the Board of Aldermen  
18 and, except as provided in this section, they shall be elected to two-year terms. In 2003,  
19 the two candidates receiving the highest numbers of votes shall be elected to four-year  
20 terms, and the three candidates receiving the next highest numbers of votes shall be  
21 elected to two-year terms. In 2005, and biennially thereafter, three members shall be  
22 elected to two-year terms. In 2007, and biennially thereafter, two members shall be  
23 elected to two-year terms.

24 "Section 3.4. **Manner of Electing Mayor; Term of Office.** The qualified voters of  
25 the entire Town shall elect the Mayor. In 2003, and biennially thereafter, the Mayor  
26 shall be elected for a term of two years.

27 "ARTICLE IV. ELECTIONS.

28 "Section 4.1. **Conduct of Town Elections.** Elections shall be conducted on a  
29 nonpartisan basis and the results determined by a plurality as provided in G.S. 163-292.

30 "ARTICLE V. ADMINISTRATION.

31 "Section 5.1. **Town to Operate Under Mayor-Council Plan.** The Town of Sunset  
32 Harbor will operate under the Mayor-Council plan as provided in Part 3 of Article 7 of  
33 Chapter 160A of the General Statutes.

34 "Section 5.2. **Ad Valorem Taxes.** The maximum ad valorem tax rate for the Town  
35 of Sunset Harbor is hereby established as ten cents (10¢) per one hundred dollars  
36 (\$100.00) valuation, and the Board of Aldermen shall not increase that rate without the  
37 vote or consent of a majority of the qualified voters of the Town of Sunset Harbor."

38 **SECTION 2.** From and after the effective date of this act, the citizens and  
39 property in the Town of Sunset Harbor shall be subject to municipal taxes levied for the  
40 year beginning July 1, 2003, and for that purpose, the Town shall obtain from  
41 Brunswick County a record of property in the area incorporated in Section 1 of this act  
42 that was listed for taxes as of January 1, 2003. The Town may adopt a budget ordinance  
43 for fiscal year 2003-2004 without following the timetable in the Local Government  
44 Budget and Fiscal Control Act, but shall follow the sequence of actions in the spirit of

1 the act insofar as is practical. For fiscal year 2003-2004, ad valorem taxes may be paid  
2 at par or face amount within 90 days of adoption of the budget ordinance and thereafter  
3 in accordance with the schedule in G.S. 105-360. If the effective date of incorporation is  
4 prior to July 1, 2003, the Town may adopt a budget ordinance for fiscal year 2002-2003  
5 without following the timetable in the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control  
6 Act, but shall follow the sequence of actions in the spirit of the act insofar as is  
7 practical. No ad valorem taxes may be levied for the 2002-2003 fiscal year.

8 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
