4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-163.2 is amended by adding a new subsection to			
6	read:			
7	"(b1) Verification of Withholding Allowances. – If an employee claims to be			
8	entitled to more than five withholding allowances, the employer must apply the			
9	withholding tables for that employee using the greater of five withholding allowances or			
10	the number of withholding allowances for which employee provides written verifying			
11	information. For each withholding allowance claimed for the employee and the			
12	employee's spouse and dependents, the verifying information must be the name and			
13	social security number of the person for whom the allowance is claimed. In the case of			
14	withholding allowances claimed because the taxpayer expects to have excess itemized			
15	deductions or credits, the verifying information must be the estimated amount of these			
16	excess items as well as the employee's estimated federal adjustments to income,			
17	estimated State deductions from and additions to federal taxable income, and estimated			
18	nonwage income. If an employee claims to be entitled to more than five withholding			
19	allowances and fails to provide verifying information for all allowances claimed, the			
20	employer must report the employee to the Secretary."			

21 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective for taxable years beginning on or 22 after January 1, 2004.
