Short Title: Appalachian State/Regulate Parking. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE APPALACHIAN STATE UNIVERSITY TO REGULATE
3 PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 116-44.5(2) reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 116-44.5. Special provisions applicable to identified constituent institutions of
7 the University of North Carolina.

8 In addition to the powers granted by G.S. 116-44.4, the board of trustees of each of
9 the constituent institutions enumerated hereinafter shall have the additional powers
10 prescribed:

11 ...

12 (2) The Board of Trustees of Appalachian State University may by
13 ordinance prohibit, regulate, and limit the parking of motor vehicles on
14 those portions of the following public streets in the Town of Boone
15 where parking is not prohibited by an ordinance of the Town of
16 Boone:

- 17 a. ~~Faculty~~Rivers Street, between U.S. 221-U.S. 321 (Hardin
18 Street) and Water Street;
- 19 b. Stadium Drive, between ~~Faulty~~Rivers Street and ~~Fernelift~~
20 Hemlock Drive;
- 21 c. College Street, ~~between U.S. 421 U.S. 321 (King Street) and~~
22 Locust Street; to the extent that it is bounded on both sides by
23 the university campus;
- 24 d. Appalachian Street, between Locust Street and Howard Street;
- 25 e. Brown Street, between Locust Street and Howard ~~Street~~Street;
- 26 f. Hill Street, only on the half of Hill Street bounded by the
27 university campus;
- 28 g. Stansberry Circle, from Holmes Drive to the end of Stansberry
29 Circle;

- 1 h. Locust Street, from U.S. 221-U.S. 321 (Hardin Street) to the
2 end of Locust Street; and
3 i. Dale Street, from State Farm Road to the end of Dale Street."

4 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
