SECTION 1. G.S. 20-77(d) reads as rewritten:	
"(d) An operator of a place of business for garaging, repairing, parking	or storing
vehicles for the public in which a vehicle remains unclaimed for 10 day	ys, or the
landowners upon whose property a motor vehicle has been abandoned for mo	re than 30
days, shall, within five days after the expiration of that period, report the	vehicle as
unclaimed to the Division. Failure to make such report shall constitute	a Class 3
misdemeanor. Persons who are required to make this report and who fail to do	so within
the time period specified may collect other charges due but may not colle	ct storage
charges for the period of time between when they were required to make this	report and
when they actually did send the report to the Division by certified mail.
