A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT ALLOWING THE STATE, COUNTIES, AND CITIES TO REPAIR OR CONSTRUCT CERTAIN STRUCTURES WITHOUT HAVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE STRUCTURES PREPARED BY A REGISTERED ARCHITECT OR ENGINEER.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. G.S. 133-1.1(c) reads as rewritten:  "(c) The following shall be excepted from the requirements of subsection (a) of	
this section:	
(1)	Dwellings and outbuildings in connection therewith, such as barns and private garages.
(2)	
(3)	Buildings used for agricultural purposes other than schools or assembly halls which are not within the limits of a city or an incorporated village.
(4)	Temporary buildings or sheds used exclusively for construction purposes, not exceeding 20 feet in any direction, and not used for living quarters.
<u>(5)</u>
