SECTION 1. Article 1 of Chapter 75 of the General Sta	tutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:	·
"§ 75-36. Certain contracts relating to toner or inkjet ca	rtridges void and
unenforceable as a matter of public policy.	
Any provision in any agreement or contract that prob	nibits the reusing,
remanufacturing, or refilling of a toner or inkjet cartridge is void and	d unenforceable as a
matter of public policy. Nothing in this section shall prevent any m	naintenance contract
that warrants the performance of equipment under the contract from	requiring the use of
new or specified toner or inkjet cartridges in the equipment under co	ontract."
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2	2003, and applies to
agreements or contracts entered into on or after that date. This act of	does not apply to or
affect any litigation pending before that date.
