A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO COMBAT THE MANUFACTURE OF METHAMPHETAMINE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice the sum of five hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$585,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to combat the manufacture or production of methamphetamine. Of the funds appropriated in this act, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be used to lease additional space at the western laboratory of the State Bureau of Investigation and five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$560,000) shall be used to create seven new sworn drug chemist positions and two new sworn latent print examiner positions in the State Bureau of Investigation, effective January 1, 2005.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
