11	facilities of a manufacturing plant.		
12	(2) The Governor has acknowledged the disaster through the creat		
13	such task forces as are needed to coordinate State assistance	to the	
14	manufacturer and its employees.		
15	(3) The Governor has issued an Executive Order directing and author	•	
16	the Employment Security Commission to waive the waiting we	ek for	
17	employees of the manufacturer.		
18	(4) The Employment Security Commission shall implement regul		
19	prescribing the procedure for the waiver of the waiting period w	eek in	
20	accordance with G.S. 96-4(b)."
