**BILL SUMMARY:** This bill adds a member to the Board of the North Carolina Indian Cultural Center to represent the Occaneechi Band of the Saponi Nation of Alamance and Orange Counties.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** The Indian Cultural Center Board is a non-profit organization. The Board currently has 17 members and this bill adds one additional member. The North Carolina Commission of Indian Affairs appoints members to the Indian Cultural Center Board but has no administrative oversight of the organization. Therefore, this bill will have no fiscal impact on the Commission of Indian Affairs housed in the Department of Administration.
