HOUSE BILL 146 Short Title: Legislative Assistant Status. (Public) **Sponsors:** Representatives Miller; Rayfield, Bell, Tucker, and Stam. Referred to: Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House. February 9, 2005 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT EACH MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ENTITLED TO A FULL-TIME LEGISLATIVE ASSISTANT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 7 of Chapter 120 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 120-32.6. Members entitled to full-time legislative assistant. Each member of the General Assembly is entitled to have one full-time legislative assistant during the entire term of office. That assistant shall be classified either as temporary or permanent. For the purpose of this section, "full-time" means 40 hours per week." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
