9			under rules adopted by the Commission. Yard trash that is source		
10			separated from solid waste may be accepted at a solid waste disposal		
11			area where the area provides and maintains separate yard trash		
12			composting facilities.		
13		(4)	White goods.		
14		(5)	Antifreeze (ethylene glycol).		
15		(6)	Aluminum cans.		
16		(7)	Whole scrap tires, as provided in G.S. 130A-309.58(b). The		
17			prohibition against landfilling The prohibition of the disposal of whole		
18			scrap tires in landfills applies to all whole pneumatic rubber coverings,		
19			but does not apply to whole solid rubber coverings.		
20		(8)	Lead-acid batteries, as provided in G.S. 130A-309.70.		
21		<u>(9)</u>	Oyster shells."
