Section 10.59F of S.L. 2005-276, as amended by Section 20 of 9 S.L. 2005-345, and Part 34 of Article 3 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes are 10 11 repealed. SECTION 2. Effective June 30, 2006, funds in the Reserve for the 12 Governor's Vision Care Program shall revert to the General Fund. 13 14 **SECTION 3.** Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act is effective
