8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
9	SECTION 1. Section 10.59F of S.L. 2005-276, as amended by Section 20 of
10	S.L. 2005-345, and Part 35 of Article 3 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes are
11	repealed.
12	SECTION 2. Effective June 30, 2006, funds in the Reserve for the
13	Governor's Vision Care Program shall revert to the General Fund.
14	SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act is effective
15	when it becomes law.
