AN ACT ALLOWING THE CITY OF ARCHDALE TO EXERCISE
EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OVER AN AREA EXTENDING TWO
MILES FROM ITS LIMITS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION</b> 1. Notwithstanding the population provisions in
G.S. 160A-360(a), the City of Archdale may exercise the extraterritorial jurisdiction
powers granted in Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes within a defined
area extending not more than two miles beyond its corporate limits. Except as
otherwise provided by this act, the extension of extraterritorial jurisdiction by the City
of Archdale is subject to the provisions of G.S. 160A-360.
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
