SESSION LAW 2005-202 SENATE BILL 338

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF AHOSKIE TO GIVE ANNUAL NOTICE TO CHRONIC VIOLATORS OF THE TOWN'S OVERGROWN VEGETATION ORDINANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of S.L. 1999-58, as amended by S.L. 2000-33, S.L. 2000-38, S.L. 2001-107, S.L. 2003-77, S.L. 2003-80, and S.L. 2005-81, reads as rewritten:

"Section 2. This act applies to the Towns of <u>Ahoskie</u>, Ayden, Leland, and Pineville, and to the Cities of Durham, Gastonia, High Point, Lexington, Monroe, Roanoke Rapids, Rocky Mount, and Winston-Salem only."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 20th day of July, 2005.
