1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FEE PAID BY DWI OFFENDERS FOR ATTENDING
3	AN ALCOHOL AND DRUG EDUCATION TRAFFIC SCHOOL, TO INCREASE
4	THE AMOUNT REMITTED FROM THE FEE BY A FACILITY TO THE
5	DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, TO INCREASE THE
6	QUALIFICATIONS OF PERSONS WHO WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO PROVIDE
7	ADET SCHOOL INSTRUCTION, TO DIRECT THE COMMISSION ON
8	MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE
9	ABUSE SERVICES TO MODIFY THE RULES REGARDING THE NUMBER OF
10	INSTRUCTIONAL HOURS AND MAXIMUM ADET SCHOOL CLASS SIZE,
11	AND TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH AN OUTCOMES
12	EVALUATION STUDY ON THE EFFECTIVENESS OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE
13	SERVICES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT
14	COMMITTEE ON MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES,
15	AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES.
16	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
17	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 122C-142.1(f) reads as rewritten:
18	"(f) Fees. – A person who has a substance abuse assessment conducted for the
19	purpose of obtaining a certificate of completion shall pay to the assessing agency a fee
20	of one hundred dollars (\$100). A person shall pay to a treatment facility or school a fee
21	of seventy five dollars (\$75.00).one hundred sixty dollars (\$160.00). A person shall pay
22	to a treatment facility a fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00). If the defendant is treated
23	by an area mental health facility, G.S. 122C-146 applies after receipt of the seventy-five
24	dollar (\$75.00) fee.
25	A facility that provides to a person who is required to obtain a certificate of
26	completion a substance abuse assessment, an ADET school, or a substance abuse
27	treatment program may require the person to pay a fee required by this subsection
28	before it issues a certificate of completion. As stated in G.S. 122C-146, however, an

area facility may not deny a service to a person because the person is unable to pay.

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(Public)

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1	<u>A An area facility shall remit to the Department five percent (5%) ten percent (10%)</u>
2	of each fee paid to the area-facility under this subsection by a person who attends an
3	ADET school conducted by the area facility. The Department may use amounts remitted
4	to it under this subsection only to support, evaluate, and administer ADET schools."
5	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 122C-142.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to
6	read:
7	"(d1) Persons Authorized to Provide Instruction. – Individuals who provide ADET
8	school instruction as a Department-authorized ADETS instructor must have at least one
9	of the following qualifications:
10	(1) Certified Substance Abuse Counselor (CSAC), as defined by the
11	Commission.
12	(2) Certified Clinical Addiction Specialist (CCAS), as defined by the
13	Commission.
14	(3) <u>Certified Substance Abuse Prevention Consultant (CSAPC), as defined</u>
15	by the Commission."
16	SECTION 3. The Commission on Mental Health, Developmental
17	Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services shall revise its rules regarding the number of
18	instructional program hours and the class size for ADET schools. The minimum
19	program hours of instruction shall not be less than 16 hours. The maximum class size
20	shall not be more than 20 participants.
21	<b>SECTION 4.(a)</b> G.S. 122C-142.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to
22	read:
23	"(j) The Department shall establish an outcomes evaluation study on the
24	effectiveness of substance abuse services provided to persons who obtain a certificate of
25	completion under G.S. 20-17.6 as a condition for restoration of a drivers license. The
26	findings of the study shall be reported every two years to the Joint Legislative
27	Commission on Governmental Operations."
28	SECTION 4.(b) The Department shall submit an initial report on the
29	findings of the study established under Section 4(a) of this act to the Commission no
30	later than December 31, 2007.
31	<b>SECTION 5.</b> Section 1 becomes effective when the rules adopted under
32	Section 3 of this act become effective and shall apply to fees charged for ADET school
33	instruction that commences on or after that date. Section 2 becomes effective on January
34	1, 2009. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
