A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE ENTERPRISE TIER STRUCTURE UNDER THE WILLIAM S. LEE QUALITY JOBS AND BUSINESS EXPANSION ACT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 105-129.3(d) reads as rewritten: "(d) Exception for Two County Multi-Jurisdictional Industrial Park. – For the purpose of this Article, an eligible two county industrial park created by interlocal agreement under G.S. 158-7.4 has the lower lowest enterprise tier designation of the designations of the two-counties in which it is located if it meets all-both of the following conditions:		
(1)	It is <u>located_located</u> , at one or more sites, in two or more co- counties, one <u>or more</u> of which has a lower enterprise tier des than the <u>other.others</u> .	
(2)	At least one third of the park is located in the county with tier designation.	he lower
(3)	It is owned by the two counties two or more units of local government.	<u>/ernment</u>
(4)	The county with the lower tier designation contributed at lesser of one half of the cost of developing the park or a prop the cost of developing the park equal to the proportion of lar park located in the county with the lower tier designation."	ortion of
