The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Columbus		

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Columbus County the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for the construction of a new facility for the Columbus County Department of Aging and Adult Services, which will provide adequate space for programs and services to meet the needs of the County's growing senior population.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
